You get a number of tools and experiences that you can keep using. Your project will develop from the many questions and the coaching process. On top you get to network with the other participants and test your project in an international context.

The lab is aimed at the following formats: fiction TV-series, fiction and documentary feature length incl. animation, long format short films (30 - 45 min.) - from long synopsis/treatment stage to almost finished productions. For TV-series the 1st draft of the pilot needs to be in place to get the most out of the lab.
